#### Need/ Reason for OLT Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) Upgrades

Ever sit on the Oak House back porch on a hot summer day? The not so pleasant aroma is from OLT's wastewater system that is over 30 years old ! Time for an upgrade ! OLT anticipated these much needed improvements and began taking steps toward upgrading its wastewater facilities several years ago. At the same time the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment began to more closely scrutinize water/ sewer systems across the state in 2009. OLT became state-mandated to complete this project by the end of 2014.

The WWTP upgrades will include the installation of 440 Infiltrators, one large holding / processing tank and a lot of piping and labor. With the additional excavation and other potential labor and engineering design costs the impact on OLT's budget is estimated at **\$180,000**. OLT will take out loans to finance the project but NEEDS YOUR HELP TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT AND PAY OFF THE LOANS!

The new WWTP will be odorless, silent and removed from view. It is expected to last for 30 or more years. The WWTP campaign is not a glamorous project but it is necessary and will improve your Valley View experience tremendously!
